



## Mucinous carcinoma of the breast

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Mucinous carcinoma of the breast is the third most common histological subtype of breast cancer, comprising approximately 2% to 5% of invasive breast carcinomas. Although it is regarded as a favorable prognosis subtype, recurrences may still occur.

We will review the clinicopathologic features of mucinous breast cancer, including data on the genomic features. The challenges of developing evidence-based treatment guidelines for this subtype of breast cancer will also be discussed.
